COMPETITION RULES

- All participants in FIS competitions must wear reinforced protective helmets and protective glasses! It is mandatory for participants of youth, children and veteran groups to wear reinforced safety helmets and preferably safety glasses! If the participants finish without or with an unfastened safety helmet, he is disqualified. The competition jury announces the possibility not to use protective glasses. Such a decision may be made in cases where the weather makes it difficult to see when wearing goggles.
- 2. **In freestyle competitions,** it is allowed to start with roller skis, the parameters of which are as follows:
 - in V10-16 and S10-16 groups START SKATING 71 roller skis : wheel diameter ≤ 71mm; width ≥ 30mm:
 - In groups V18, V20, V, V40, V50, S18, S20, S, S40, S50: black RUBBER wheels, diameter ≤100mm; frame length ≥ 530mm.

In classical style competitions, it is allowed to start with roller skis, the parameters of which are as follows:

- In FIS competitions, classic style roller skis with black FF wheels with a V-groove, diameter ≤ 80mm. Each roller ski must have at least one wheel with a brake mechanism ;

(we invite you to use your rollers with FF V-groove, but the rollers will be provided for the others at the FIS competition on August 24. After the competition, it will be possible to buy them for €140)



- In other LČ group competitions, roller skis with black wheels, hardness ≤80A shors , diameter ≤ 80mm. Each roller ski must have at least one wheel with a brake mechanism.

Participants must ensure that their inventory complies with the rules. The competition jury will conduct an inspection at the specified time before the start, as well as randomly after the finish

- 3. According to FIS ICR 396.2.6, cross-country ski poles with cross-country tips (baskets) must be used in FIS roller skiing competitions. If roller ski pole tips are used, they must have a hard plastic safety sleeve with a diameter of at least 30mm. This protective sleeve must not be higher than 45 mm above the metal tip.
- 4. In races with an interval start, the participant who is overtaken must give way to the faster driver at the first request.
- 5. Registration for the competition takes place through the LSF website no later than 2 days before the first day of the competition of the respective stage (until Wednesday 23:59). Due to technical reasons, the application can be submitted in writing (e-mail) to the LSF e-mail:

- Teams, sports schools are invoiced for participation in the competition for all registered participants.

 of the competition before arriving for registration.
